At pages 111 to 125 of the attached file are details of an Audit undertaken in September 2015 of the Forces handling of Complaints via JARAC.



Has there been any subsequent audits? if so can you please provide me with a copy

We do hold the information and can confirm the following:

There has yet to be a further audit in this particular area although it is on the list of thematic areas considered for the cyclical plan over a 3-year period. This plan is put together based on the risk-assessment of the Chief Finance Officer (CFO) and Finance Director (FD) combined with the advice of the internal auditor and JARAC. Your question is appreciated and we will ensure it is discussed with the Chair of JARAC.

If you are not satisfied with the outcome of the internal review under Section 50 of the FOIA you can apply directly to the Information Commissioner (ICO) for a decision.
