Vehicle Conversions

The force is due to take delivery of 19 new vehicles in February 2022 which will require conversion - 5 x Roads Policing, 2 x Armed Response and 12 x Section Response.

There will also be an ongoing requirement for vehicle conversion for Roads Policing and Armed Response throughout 2022/23. At present an additional 5 x RPU and 2 x ARU vehicles.

A compliant route to market has been identified via the Sussex Police Vehicle Conversions Framework Agreement JPS648, Lot 6.

A further competition was advertised on the EU Portal against the framework inviting the named suppliers to submit their bids.

12 expressions of interest were received, 9 bids were submitted of which 7 were compliant and therefore taken forward to evaluation against the published criteria of 80% price, 20% quality.

A.J. Engineering Services Ltd were the successful bidder achieving the highest score

The contract will be for an initial 2 year term with the option to extend for 2 x 12 months.

The value of the initial order for 19 vehicles is £85,420.45 with the total value over the initial term estimated in the region of £136,000 with the additional 2 x RPU and 5 x ARU vehicles expected to be delivered during 2022/23.
